Combined Cub Scout Leader Training (All one class)
8:00 AM – 1:30 PM

- **Cub Scout Den Leader Specific Training**

This course is intended to provide Tiger Cub, Wolf, Bear, and Webelos den leaders with the information and tools they need to conduct successful den meetings. Den leaders who complete the Tiger Cub, Wolf, and Bear training and Youth Protection training are considered trained for all three positions. Den leaders who complete the Webelos training and Youth Protection training are considered trained as Webelos den leaders.

- **Cubmaster and Assistant Cubmaster Position-Specific Training**

This course is intended to provide Cubmasters with the information and tools they need to successfully lead a Cub Scout pack. Cubmasters and assistants who complete this training and Youth Protection training are considered “trained” for both positions.

- **Pack Committee Challenge—Pack Committee Position-Specific Training**

The Pack Committee Challenge is designed for pack committees and is the course (along with Youth Protection training) pack committee members need to be considered “trained.”

BSA Scoutmaster / Assistant Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training

8:00 AM - 12:30 PM

This is the initial training for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters (and other interested persons). This course covers the essentials of their leadership positions and provides information to help them become successful Scout leaders. Learn about working with the boys, troop organization, the patrol method, the outdoor program, the advancement program, and planning. Scoutmasters/Assistant Scoutmasters must also attend the Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills Training to be considered “Trained”.

Merit Badge Counselor Training (Following SM Leader Specific Training)

12:30 PM – 1:30 PM

Learn all about being a merit badge counselor, from getting registered to how the merit badge process works. No charge if you only take this course. This course is a one-time requirement for all Merit Badge Counselors

Charter Organization Representative (COR) Training (Following SM Leader Specific Training)

12:45 PM – 1:30 PM

As a COR, you hold a key position in Scouting. This training will help you understand your responsibilities and relationships between units, chartered organizations, and the council. This course is a one-time requirement for all CORs.

Commissioner Basic Training

8:00 AM – 12:00 PM

The mission of unit service is to help units serve more youth better through Scouting. This training will examine what a Commissioner is, what a Commissioner does, and how a Commissioner does it.

District Committee Training Workshop

8:00 AM – 12:00 PM

The District Committee Training Workshop meets the basic training need of members of the district committee. The workshop also results in a well-coordinated and dedicated group of Scouters committed to achieving the mission of the council and its districts.
